MyAccountingLab

Meet the Power of Practice! MyAccountingLab is an online homework and assessment tool that supports the same theme as the text by providing “I get it!” moments inside and outside of class. It is in MyAccountingLab where “I get it!” moments meet the power of practice.

MyAccountingLab:

- Helps students at their teachable moment, whether that is at 1 p.m. or 1 a.m.
- Includes algorithmically generated versions of the same end-of-chapter material in the text that students are used to doing as homework.
- Features a similar look and feel to the text so that students find it familiar and comfortable to work with.

In MyAccountingLab, instructors can:

- Create homework assignments that cover a wide variety of accounting questions.
- Copy a sample homework assignment, or create a new assignment from scratch using questions from the textbook.
- Select questions from any chapter and objective in *Accounting*.
- Select start dates, due dates, allow printing, and even allow partial credit.

In MyAccountingLab, students can access a wide variety of learning tools:

- An individualized **Study Plan** that shows them which topics they have mastered and which ones need additional practice.
- **DemoDocs**, comprehensive worked-through problems to help students when they are trying to solve exercises and problems on their own. Entire problems that mirror end-of-chapter material are presented in Flash format and narrated in a conversational style, essentially imitating what an instructor might say if standing over a student’s shoulder.
- **Help Me Solve It**, a step-by-step interactive tutoring feature that walks students through the steps required to complete each question. Students can use Help Me Solve It to guide them to the solution for a question, and then regenerate the question with new values so they can practice what they’ve learned.
- **Concept Lecture Videos**, commissioned specifically to accompany *Accounting*, provide additional reinforcement of core accounting concepts.
- A comprehensive flash-based **E-text** links students directly to the relevant chapter content and support materials whenever they need reinforcement or clarification.

Depending on the assignment, students can work on multiple-choice questions, simple starter questions, exercises, and complicated problems. Students can also work on quizzes and even tests that the instructor can decide when and how they access.

MyAccountingLab is yet another tool in providing students with the help they need to “get it” in accounting!
